# Conduct during COVID-19

## For Foreign Caregivers

- The rise in the number of new cases poses a risk to assisted patients and to tightening restrictions which apply to all of us.

### Take care of yourselves!

- **You must** follow the rules: observing hand hygiene, wearing a face mask, maintaining social distancing - two meters between individuals - will help in preventing infection. Disregarding the rules is one of the main causes of increasing infections.

### Know your rights!

- If you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, such as fever or respiratory symptoms, you should get tested as soon as possible.
- You must contact your medical service, such as Kupat Holim or your private health insurance, and ask for instructions on how to undergo a COVID-19 test.
- Should you be found sick, you will be sent to a hotel authorized by Kupat Holim or according to the instructions of the Ministry of Health.

### You should know

- Enforcement against crowds in the public spaces across Israel has been tightened. Violations of the rules are handled by the Israeli Police in way of imposing high fines.
